The Six Things

1. Mormon scripture teaches that *all* the various Christian denominations, particularly the Presbyterians, Baptists and Methodists, are all considered by Jesus Christ to be "wrong", their creeds are all an "abomination", and all those who believe in them are "corrupt". Mormon scripture, prophets and apostles teach that there is more than one god who created this world, that there are many gods who rule over other worlds, and that worthy Mormons may one day become gods themselves. Even though Mormons claim there is only one God for them, they still believe that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are separate gods who are only one in their purpose rather than in a being which they share eternally.
